The position is part of the research project YELLOWPOL “The Yellow Vests Movement Impact on the 2019 European elections: online/offline polarization” funded by FNSP-SAB. We offer an exciting work environment for interdisciplinary research between social and data sciences. You will have your own work space with all the necessary equipment at Sciences Po.

### Your tasks will be:

- Research on the political use of digital media by French citizens in the context of the emergence of the Yellow Vests (YV) movement and the 2019 European Parliamentary elections.
- Processing, quantitative analysis and visualization of social media data coming from YV groups (accessed through Facebook Crowdtangle API)
- Writing working papers/ reports

### Mandatory competences:

- MSc degree (completed) or PhD degree (in completion) in computer sciences, NLP, machine learning or data science at large
- Knowledge of computational sciences (e.g. text and data mining, analysis of social media, topic modeling, social network analysis, etc.)
- Good coding skills (preferably in R or python)
- Good command of English (spoken and written)
- Knowledge in the field of political sciences (welcome but not mandatory)
